To participate in this project, your lace must have started after the May 2017 meeting. If you are doing a continuation of a lace you have already started you must mark the point from which you will continue and work two yards from that point. If you have worked two yards and you want to join the yardage club, you need not cut it off if you do not choose to do so. Just ask the Yardage Club Chairman take a photo of your project and measure your lace.

Turn your lace strip, pricking, and project sheet in to the Yardage Club Chairman. All will be returned. Your lace will make you eligible to become a member of the **L.A.C.E. Guild Crochet Lace Yardage Club** and we hope to see your lace on the edge of your mob hat or on your sleeves at your next demonstration.

You will be presented with a certificate at the next Yardage Club recognition; date to be announced.
